

#### Ash Wednesday/Lent

Ash Wednesday comes early this year on 22<sup>nd</sup> February, marking the beginning of our Lenten journey. Lent is a special Season of the Church's Liturgical Year. It begins on Ash Wednesday where Catholics around the world attend a special Liturgy where we are marked with the ashes on our foreheads. It is a period where we as Christians pray, fast and give. Our school will be gathering for our own Ash Wednesday Liturgy on the 22<sup>nd</sup> February which you are welcome to be part of. All our children will be marked on their forehead with the ashes that were from the burnt palms of last year's Palm Sunday celebration. ## **PB4L Journey**

PB4L is a school wide framework which helps to build a culture of positive behavior and learning. We began our PB4L journey at St. Mary's in 2020. Each fortnight we teach our specific behavior focus, whilst also reminding âkonga of our school values of care, courtesy, respect and responsibility. Children's good choices are recognized by teachers and teaching assistants and rewarded with a token, alongside a brief comment about what behavior was noticed. Tokens are collected within teams, where we work towards a shared reward. These rewards are generated and chosen with the children in each team and vary across the school. The teaching focus for term 1 are:

- Look after your and others' belongings
- Enter and leave in an orderly way
- Allow others to learn
- Use kind words and actions
- Be considerate of others

We look forward to sharing more about PB4L throughout the year.
